Introduction: Who are you, and what is your relationship with the deceased? Even if you know most of the funeral guests, introducing yourself makes who you are clear for everyone.

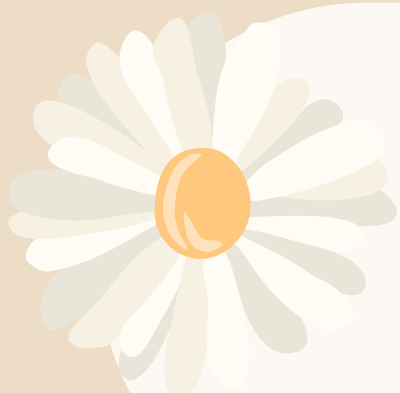


Tell A Story
